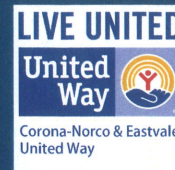

FAMILY SUPPORT SERVICES AT CORONA-NORCO UNITED WAY

Family Support Services focuses on providing crisis intervention, needs assessment, safety planning and psycho-education to adults and children who are victims of domestic violence. The program offers support to our clients in immediate or imminent danger of being hurt by an intimate partner or to children who are abused, neglected or have witnessed family violence.

The Family Support Services program is operated out of the Corona-Norco United Way offices in partnership with the City of Corona, the Corona Police Department and individual donations like yours. The program launched in 2015.

Program Goals:

- To Address Client's Safety.
- Develop a Plan of Action for preventing recurring violence in the family.
- To provide victims with additional tools to obtain self-sufficiency.

Program Services:

Individuals in the program receive:

- **Case Management:** Work one-on-one with a case manager to assess the family's strengths, set and work on goals and connect to additional community resources.
- **Crisis Intervention:** Address the immediate safety of the client family in order to implement a Plan of Action intended to stabilize the threat of further violence with assistance of law enforcement agencies, Child Protective Services, the court system and other community service providers.
- **Children Support Services:** School aged children and adolescents are offered 6 individual or family group psycho-education sessions (with siblings) to support them with processing feelings, learning to communicate effectively with others and develop positive self-esteem. *PARENTAL PERMISSION IS REQUIRED.*
- **Parenting/Support Group:** Provides parents with a venue to discuss common problems that come from Domestic Violence and/or parenting children growing up in an unsafe environment. The main goal of support groups and Parenting classes is empowerment through education, and strength in numbers.



Eligibility Requirements:

The FSS program serves families who:

- Live within the Corona-Norco United Way service area (Corona, Norco and Eastvale and surrounding unincorporated areas).
- The individual is in immediate or imminent danger.

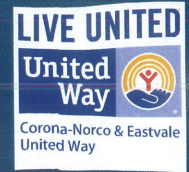

EL PROGRAMA DE APOYO FAMILIAR DE CORONA-NORCO UNITED WAY

El Programa de Servicios de Apoyo a la Familia (Familia Support Services) se enfoca en proveer servicios de intervención en crisis, evaluación de necesidades, planeación y educación para adultos y niños los cuales han sido víctimas de violencia doméstica. El programa ofrece apoyo a personas en peligro inminente que han sido violentadas por su pareja o niños abusados y en situación de descuido que han presenciado violencia familiar.

El Programa de Servicios de Apoyo a la Familia (Familia Support Services) es operado por Corona-Norco & Eastvale United Way en conjunto con: La Ciudad de Corona, Jefatura de Policia de Corona y donaciones de personas como usted. Este programa inicio en el 2015.

Metas del Programa:

- Promover la seguridad de los menores y su familia.
- Establecer un plan de acción para prevenir la violencia intrafamiliar.
- Proveer a las víctimas de violencia o abuso domestico con las herramientas necesarias para que alcancen autosuficiencia.

Servicios Del Programa:

Las personas en el programa reciben:

- **Manejo de caso:** Trabajo personalizado con un representante del programa que evaluara las fortalezas familiares para sugerir las estrategias necesarias estableciendo metas.
- **Intervencion en crisis:** Se buscara de manera inmediata la seguridad del cliente y su familia estableciendo un plan de acción que neutralice cualquier amenaza de violencia con la asistencia de las Autoridades Policiacas, Servicios de Protección al Menor, Sistema judicial y cualquier otra agencia de Servicios a la Comunidad.
- **Servicios de apoyo a menores:** Menores y Adolescentes reciben al menos 6 sesiones individuales o familiares, en sesiones de terapia educativas con miembros de la familia se fortalece al menor en el manejo de sus emociones y aprender a comunicarse de manera efectiva con otras personas además de desarrollar una autoestima positiva. (SE REQUIERE LA AUTORIZACION DE LOS PADRES)
- **Criansa de los hijos/Grupos de Apoyo:** Provee a las madres y padres un canal para discutir problemas comunes derivados de la violencia domestica y/o criansa de hijos(a) que estan creciendo en ambientes inseguros. La meta de este programa es doble: Conferir poder atravez de la educacion y confirmar que la fuerza esta en la mayoria.



Requisitos para recibir servicios:

- Vivir en el área de servicio de Corona-Norco & Eastvale United Way (Corona, Norco y Eastvale y sus áreas no-incorporadas)
- Estar en riesgo inminente de violencia intrafamiliar.

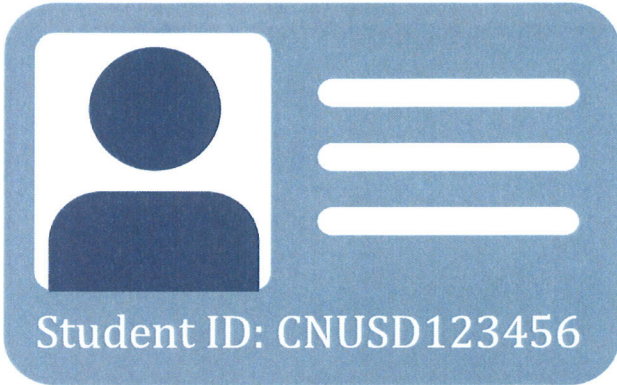
