The Corona Public Library Adult Reading Assistance Program serves community members by providing free tutoring in basic reading and writing skills for adults. Participants must be native or fluent English speakers.

BECOME OR REFER A STUDENT

Each student is matched with a tutor who meets with them at the library at a time that fits both their schedules. The program offers free resources to assist adults in achieving their individual literacy-related goals, including workbooks, online learning programs, special events and meetings with other learners and tutors. 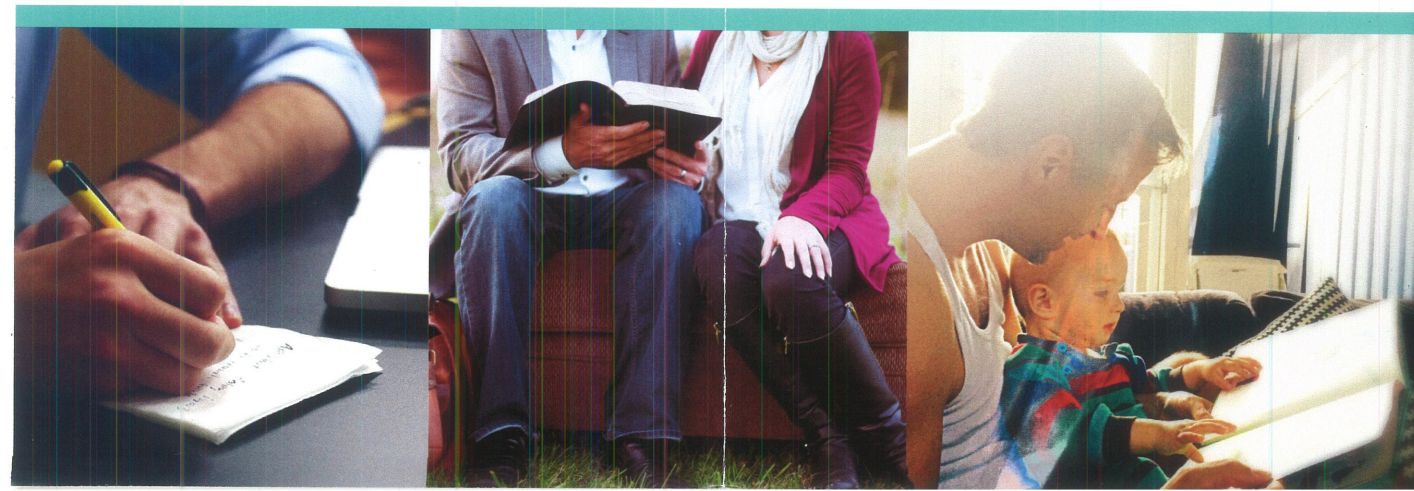

Career Online High School- COHS **Corona Public Library**

What is it? COHS is an online high school diploma and career certification program offered through Corona Public Library. The library offers a limited number of scholarships each year.

Who is eligible to apply? Adults who are at least 19-years-old, have at least completed the 8th grade, and have a Corona Public Library card in good standing or be willing to apply for one.

Steps to apply for a scholarship:

- **SELF ASSESSMENT:** Click on the "self-assessment questionnaire" link. Select **Corona Public Library** as your library, fill out and submit.
- **PRE-REQUISITE COURSE:** You will receive an email within 5 days if you are eligible. Then you need to select a career major (there are 10 options) and enroll in the 2-week online prerequisite course.
- **INTERVIEW:** If you successfully complete the prerequisite course on time with a score of 70% or better, you will be scheduled for an interview.
